

HOW TO CARE FOR YOUR GRANITE COUNTERTOPS

1. Clean granite or other stone with dishwashing detergent water. Rinse with clean water and allow to dry.
2. Use generous application of denatured alcohol and spread with your hand. Use latex disposable glove if you wish. Alcohol is harmless and evaporates leaving behind no residue. Salvage a household or personal product lotion bottle (or similar container with a small spout) to be used as your applicator bottle. Then transfer alcohol to the bottle for convenience.
3. Wipe up excess alcohol with absorbent, clean cotton towel or face cloth.
4. That's it. Your countertops are clean, sanitized and look like new.
5. Granite **MUST** be sealed periodically to prevent excessive absorption of liquids. Apply recommended sealers after initial installation (if the installer or contractor did not already seal the stone) and then, every year thereafter. Read the manufacturer's literature and directions. Follow them exactly.
